AGREEMENT BETWEEN C. H. FULTON AND W. S. PRITCHARD, REFERENCE IMPROVEMENTS ON CERTAIN LANDS LOCATED IN SECTION 6, TOWNSHIP 21, RANGE 2 WEST, SHELBY COUNTY, ALABAMA.

WHEREAS, C. H. Fulton and W. S. Pritchard own jointly certain lands situated in Section 6, and jointly are the beneficial owners of the stock of Lake Collegly Company, which own certain lands in Section 6, all in Township 21, Range 2 West, and that each desire to enter into this agreement for and on account of the mutual benefits flowing to each. In consideration of the premises it is hereby agreed that all improvements now upon certain lands erected thereon by C. H. Fulton shall be and remain the property of the said Fulton; that the improvements on the land purchased from T. W. Whitfield, paid for by W. S. That each of said parties shall have the right at any time they may see fit, without the casent of the other, touse, improve or demolish any of said improvements, and take any other action whatever as t they see fit, notwithstanding said title to said lands is jointly in said persons or in the Leke Cleedy Company, Inc.
