Begin at a point 21 feet West of the SE corner of the SE of SW of Sec. 36 - Tp. 21 S. Range 1 West and run South 860-15' West along South side of said 40 acres, 420 feet to the East side of Columbiana and Shelby Public Road, Thence North 230-45! West along the East side of said Road - 222 Feet to the point of beginning of the lot hereby conveyed; thence North 200-25 West along the East line of said Road 220 feet - Thence 860-151 East 420 feet, thence South 20 -251 East 210 feet; thence South 860-151 West 420 feet to point of beginning, containing 2 acres, more or less.

In the event it becomes necessary or desirable for Alabama Power Company to move its lines of poles, towers and appliances in connection with the construction or improvement of any public road or highway in proximity to its said power lines, the said Company is hereby granted the right to relocate its said lines of poles, towers and appliances on lands of grantors hereinabove described, provided, however, the said Company shall relocate its said line of poles or towers at a distance not greater than ten feet outside the boundary of the right of way of any such public road or highway as established orerevestablished from time to time.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns, forever.
