Before the undersigned authority personally appeared Charles W. Williams who is known to me and who being by me first duly sworn deposes and says:

I was acquainted with Mr. J. F. Pope of Wilsonville, Alabama. Some years prior to his death I was, and still am, acquainted with Mrs. Elizabeth Reeves Pope who is one and the same person as Mrs. J. F. Pope, the surviving widow of J. F. Pope, deceased, who executed a deed to my wife, Juanita T. Williams on the 20th day of March, 1933, and which is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in deed book 97 at page 277, conveying the Pope homestead lot.

At the time of his death and for a long time prior thereto, to my personal knowledge, Mr. J. F. Pope resided upon the property conveyed in the aforementioned deed of Mrs. J. F. Pope to my wife, Juanita T. Williams. This property was his homestead. His widow, Mrs. J. F. Pope, continued to live on the property for a number of years after her husband's death. After my wife purchased the property on March 20, 1933, we lived in it as a home about two years and then the house burned down. Thereafter we re-built on the property and are now occupying this home as a residence.
