Douglas, a widow in hand paid by Samuel Forrest Jones the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged I do remise, release, quit claim and convey to the said Samuel Forrest Jones all my right, title, interest, and claim in or to the following described real estate to wit:

The NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 20, Township 20, Range 2 West, except 100 feet right of way to the AB&C Railroad Company.

Also a part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 20, Township 20, Range 2 West being a triangular strip on the south side of what is known as the Columbiana Road, and being separated from the remainder of said forty by said road, containing 3 acres more or less; situated in Shelby County, Alabama.
