RESTRICTIVE CLAUSE

As a further consideration, it is agreed by all concerned that these purchasing this property and who will erect any church buildings thereon will, in their work and worship, use only what is ordered or required in the New Testament, either by (1) direct command or (2) approved inspired example, or (3) necessary inference, rejecting all the inventions and devices of men, such as the use of mechanical instrments of music in connection with the worship, and of any societies other than the church of Christ, in carrying out the work of God, and to restrict its use against false teachers or those who advocate the theories of premillenialism or any other speculative teachings which are or may be causing division and disturbing the peace of churches of Christ. In the event of any division arising over these or any other questions which may come up, the title to this property inheres to those, whether a majority or a minority, who adhere to the requirements set forth in this deed.
