Before me, O.T. Gay, the undersigned authority in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared H. H. Little, who, after being by me first duly sworn to speak the truth, deposes and says;

My name is H. H. Little. I am 68 years of age and have lived in Wilton, Shelby County, Alabama, for the past fifty-four years. I recall when certain lands in the town of Wilton were sub-divided in the year 1908 by G. A. Nabors, which sub-division is known as Nabor's sub-division of the Town of Wilton, Alabama, as shown by map recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. I, having lived on lots 3 and 4 of said block 2 since the year 1916, am familiar with block 2 in said sub-division and I know the ground on which there was formerly situated a school house. To the best of my recollection, the school building was abandoned in the year 1921. I am familiar with lots 6 and 7 in said block 2 and I know that said school grounds were made up of a portion of said lots 6 and 7. I have been informed that in a deed from Katie Hicks, et als, to George A. Nabors dated December 31, 1908 recorded in Deed Book 41, Page 432 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, said school grounds were excepted from said deed and said school grounds were described as follows: Beginning at a point 263 feet south 3°30' west of the northwest corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$; thence south 34° 30' west 147.57 feet; thence south 55° 30' east 147.57 feet; thence north 34° 30' east 147.57 feet; thence north 55° 30' west 147.57 feet to the point of beginning, containing one-half acre. I have also been informed that the parcel of land described in detail above lies along an alley running in a northeasterly direction along the westerly lines of said lot 6 and 7 and that said parcel of land extends back from said alley toward Church Street, a distance of 147.57 feet. Said school house was situated approximately in the center of said parcel of land. I also am acquainted with lot 8 in said block 2, being a lot 75 feet in width and extending back 258 feet from Church Street in a northwesterly direction to an alley. The northeasterly line of said lot 8 joins said school grounds and I know of my own knowledge that said school grounds are situated on parts of lots 6 and 7 and that said grounds have never been situated on any part of said lot 8.
