REVOCATION OF POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, WHEREAS, on the 13th day of May, 1939, RECONSTRUCTION FINANCE CORPORATION, a corporation organized and existing by virtue of an Act of Congress, executed a power of attorney to EDGAR W. LONG AND FRED H. NOW, THEREFORE, the undersigned, Reconstruction Finance Corporation, does hereby revoke and cancel the above described power of attorney in so far as any rights thereunder or powers to act in the name of Reconstruction Finance Corporation are given to the said EDGAR W. LONG: the powers given to the said FRED H. FOY, of the City of Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama, to remain in full force and effect. This revocation shall be effective on and after the 18th day of September, 1946.
