Fuller and wife, Mildred Fuller, in hand paid by Willie Jackson, the receipt of what is acknowledged, we the said W. E. Fuller and wife, Mildred Fuller, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said Willie Jackson the following property for a public road right-of-way leading from his property to Creswell, Alabama, being a strip of land 20 feet wide lying on the north side of the following line viz:

Begin at the northwest corner of SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 6, Township 20, Range 3 East, and run thence west along the south line of Fraction "B" of said Section 6, Township 20, Range 3 East, a distance of 1158 feet to the eastern right-of-way of the Central of Georgia Railroad; also a strip of land 20 feet wide along the eastern line of the right-of-way of said Central of Georgia Railway Company to its intersection with the south line of the right-of-way of what is known as the Creswell-Vincent public road, and being 20 feet on the east side of said railroad more particularly described as follows:
