WARRANTY DEED

WITNESSETH: That the said J. R. Parish and Edna Parish for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar and other valuable considerations Dollars to us in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have this day granted, bargained, sold, alienated, enfeoffed and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell enfeoff and convey to the said J. H. Davis all that certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 and Ten (10) acres, in southeast (SE) corner of SE 1/4 of NE 1/4, all in Section 14. Township, 24. Range 15 East containing in all fifty acres, more or less

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD The above described tract or parcel of land, together with the tenements and appurtenances thereto belonging, or otherwise appertaining unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever. And the said J. R. Parish and Edna Parish of the first part, for themselves theirs heirs, executors and administrators, do warrant and will forever defend the title to the above described and hereby granted premises unto the party of the second part his heirs and assigns, from and against themselves, and all and every person claiming or holding under them, the said party of the first part, and against the lawful title, claim, or demand of all and every person whomsoever.
