Nash in hand paid by Alice Adkins the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged we do remise, release, quit claim and convey to the said Alice Adkins all our right, title, interest and claim in or to the following described real estate, to wit:

Commencing at the northeast corner of Section 2, Township 21, Range 3 West, and run west along the north line of said Section 865.28 feet to the east right of way line of L & N.R.R. north bound track; thence in a southerly direction along said right of way line 396.27 feet to the point of beginning of the lot herein conveyed; thence continue in a southerly direction along said right of way line 25 feet; thence turn an 89 degree and 7 minute angle to the left and run 100 feet to the west right of way line of U.S. Highway No. 31; thence in a northerly direction along said right of way line 25 feet; thence in a westerly direction, and parallel to the south line of said lot 100 feet to the point of beginning; being situated in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 2, Township 21, Range 3 West, Shelby County, Alabama.

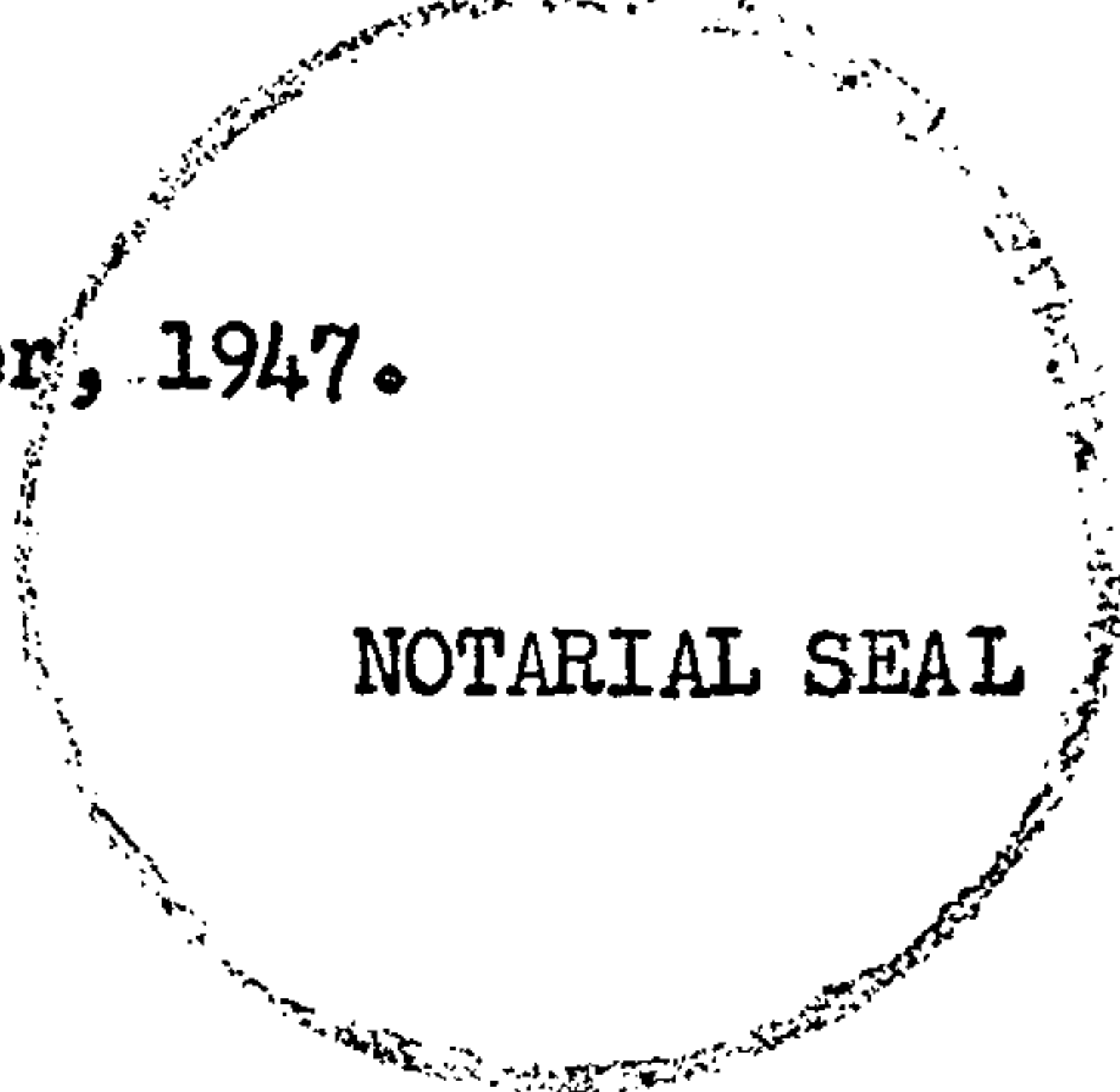

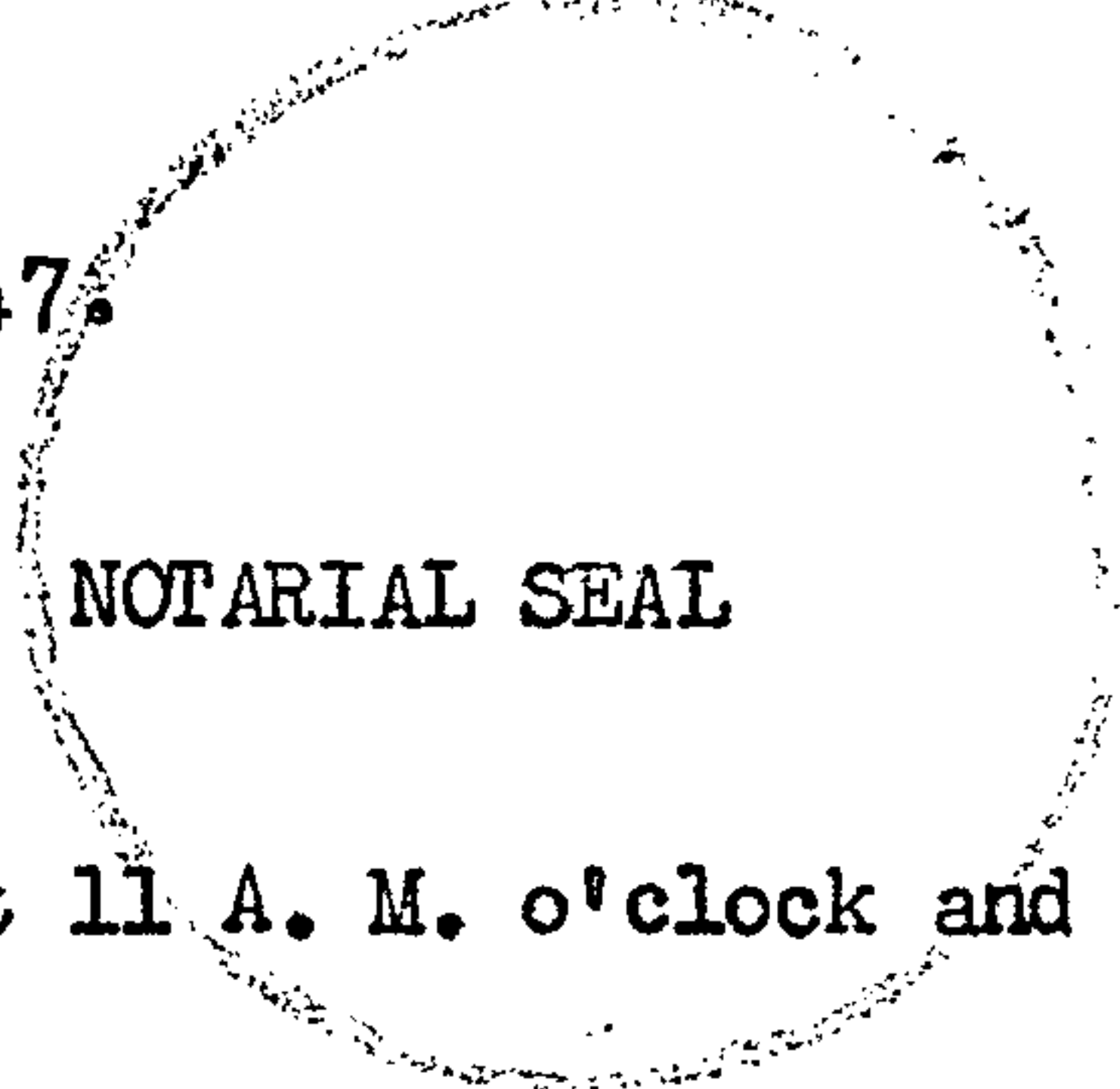
