To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Jonathan Musick of Shelby County has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa in Alabama whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Jonathan Musick according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South East fraction of Section Twenty four in Township twenty two, of range three West, in the District of Tuscaloosa and State of Alabama containing one hundred and Thirty seven acres and Twenty eight hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Jonathan Musick.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and Granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Jonathan Musick and his heirs the said tract above described. To have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Jonathan Musick and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, I James Monroe PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
