To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS James Busby, of the Shelby County, Alabama has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE AT Tuskaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the James Busby according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section twenty four, in Township twentytwo of Range three West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuskaloosa, Alabama, containing forty acres and four hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said James Busby.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said James Busby and to his heirs, the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said James Busby and to his heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, Zachary Taylor PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, here caused these letters to be made PATENT, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
