

AFFIDAVIT

STATE OF ALABAMA

Before me, the undersigned authority in and for said County in said State, personally appeared Flora Johnson who, after first being by me duly sworn to speak the truth deposes and and says:

My name is Flora Johnson. I am 44 years of age. I am the widow of James A. Johnson who died intestate on March 23, 1930. I have been familiar with the following described land for more than 25 years. Said land is described as follows:

The N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 4, Township 24, Range 13 East, containing 20 acres, of land, more or less; situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

My husband, James A. Johnson, purchased said land on January 29, 1919, from J. T. Pilgreen and wife, S. A. Pilgreen, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 69, Page 272 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. Said James A. Johnson went into immediate possession of said land at the time he purchased it and lived on it and farmed it each and every year until his death, March 23, 1930. After that time, I and the heirs of James A. Johnson continued in possession of said land and have farmed it and had it farmed each and every year until this very day. Affiant further says that during all the years she has known said land, it has been in the open, continuous, exclusive, notorious and hostile possession of James A. Johnson and his heirs and their predecessors in title and that she has never heard of anyone disputing their title or contesting their possession.

The said James A. Johnson left surviving him the following heirs at law: his widow, Affiant, Flora Johnson, and the following children: Frances Johnson Wooley, James Charles Johnson, and June Johnson Lovelady. Affiant further says there was no administration of the Estate of the said James A. Johnson and there are no unpaid claims due by his Estate.
