TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, Dickson McLendon of Shelby County has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Dickson McLendon according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1890 entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" for

the South east quarter of the south west quarter of Section seventeen in Township twenty one of Range two west, in the District of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama containing thirty nine acres and ninety seven and three fourths hundredths of an acre (Northern survey)

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Dickson McLendon

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Dickson McLendon and to his heirs, the said tract above described To have and to hold the same, together withall the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said Dickson McLendon and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I Martin Van Buren PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
