IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF Nuna Freeze, to have Erline McLeod and Ralph H. Leamous,
Relieved of the Disabilities of Nonage.

This cause coming on to be heard and having been submitted for Decree on the Petition and ex-parte
affidavits of Nuna J. Freeze, thereupon, upon consideration thereof, it is ordered, adjudged, and decreed by
the Court that Erline McLeod and Ralph H. Leamous, Minors, who are over the age of eighteen years, be, and
they are relieved of the disabilities of nonage, and they are vested with the power to sue and be sued, contract
and be contracted with, to receive and take possession of any real and personal property to which they are
entitled; to purchase Real or personal Estate, to sell and to convey, and to do all things, and to all intents
and purposes as effectually as they were twenty-one years of age.

It is further decreed that the said Nuna Freeze, pay the costs of this proceeding, for which Execution
may issue.
