Moore went into possession of said property immediately after the execution of the last mentioned deed and remained in the actual, open, notorious, exclusive, continuous adverse possession of same, cultivating portions of it or having it cultivated each and every year until he deeded it to W.A. Hale and J. Templeton on the 9th day of November, 1945, which deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama kn deed book 125 at page 554.
