Also, to submit any matter in dispute to arbitration or otherwise; with full power to make and substitute one or more Attorneys under my said Attorney and the same again at pleasure to revoke. And generally to say, do, act, transact, determine, accomplish and finish all matters and things whatsoever, relating to the premises as fully, amply and effectually, to all intents and purposes, as I the said constituent, if present, ought or might personally, although the matter should require more special authority than is hereby comprised I the said constituent ratifying, allowing and holding firm and valid, all and whatsoever my said Attorney or his substitutes shall lawfully do, or cause to be done, in and about the premises, by virtue of these presents.
