Before me, the undersigned authority in and for said County and said State, personally appeared William Bassham who, after being by me first duly sworn to speak the truth, deposes and says:

My name is William Bassham. I am 63 years of age. My wife, Carrie Bassham, and I own Block 199 according to Dunstan's Survey of Calera, Alabama, as shown by map of said survey, dated October 1, 1886. My said wife and I purchased Lot 1 of said Block 199 on November 1, 1940 from Twin Oaks Land Company as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 109, page 415 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. We went into immediate possession of said lot and cut the timber from the lot, and have been in continuous and actual possession of it until this very day.

On April 8, 1940, I purchased Lots 2 and 3 in said Block 199 from E.M. Confer and wife Willie T. Confer, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 108, page 228 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. I went into immediate possession of said lots and cut the timber on said lots and have been in continuous and actual possession of them until this day.

On march 7, 1942, I purchased Lots 4, 5 and 6 in said Block 199 from Twin Oaks Land Company as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 113, page 216 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

I went into immediate possession of these lots and cut the timber on them and a few months after I purchased these lots I built a new dwelling house on said Lot 4 in the Fall of 1946, which is the house in which I live at this time.

I built a fence around the entire said Block 199 in the Spring of 1945, and the same has been fenced in continuously since that date. I have cultivated each af said Lots in Block 199 except for Lot 4 where my house is situated and Lot 1 on Which my barn is situated each and every year since the date I purchased them.

I have been in the actual and continuous possession of said lots since the date I purchased them and have lived in said dwelling houses continuously except for the time the house was burned. No one has ever questioned my right to said lots or the possession of the same.
