Smith the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged we do remise, release, quit claim and convey to the said O.D. Smith all our right, title interest, and claim in or to the following described real estate, to-wit:

Lot Number 2, and 90 feet off the north part of Lot 1 of the Jackson Brothers Lumber Company, survey in the Town of Wilsonville, Alabama, described as follows; Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 4 and running north 90 feet; thence west 230 feet; thence south 90 feet; thence 230 feet, to point of beginning, also all that part of land lying between lots Nos. 1 and 2 and the Wilsonville and Blue Springs Public road, all being a part of the SW¹/₄ of NE¹/₄ of Section 1, Township 21, Range 1 East, also Lot no. 3 and 75 feet to the south side of Lot No. 1 of Jackson Brothers Lumber Company Survey, also a strip of land 75 feet wide and about 330 feet long running west to the Henry Garner or Butler lot, off the south side of the E¹/₂ of SE¹/₄ of NW¹/₄ of Section 1, Township 21, Range 1 East, also Lot No. 4 of Jackson Brothers Lumber Company Survey and described as follows: Beginning at the northeast corner of lot No. 3 and run north 100 feet; thence west 190 feet, thence south 90 feet; thence east 48 feet; thence south 10 feet; thence east 148 feet, to the point of beginning, and all that part of land lying north and between Lot No. 4 as described above and the Wilsonville and Blue Springs Road; also the following described land: Begin at a point where the south line of the Blue Springs Road crosses the west line of SW¹/₄ of NE¹/₄ of said Section 1 and run in a westerly direction along said road 330 feet to the east line of a certain roadway or alley; thence run in a southerly direction along the east line of said roadway or alley 268 feet; thence east 330 feet to the west line of said SW¹/₄ of SE¹/₄; thence north along west line of said forty acres 256 feet to the south line of said Blue Springs Road to the point of beginning; all in Section 1, Township 21, Range 1 East, situated in Shelby County, Alabama.
