FINAL DECREE.

This cause came on for hearing before a jury, on the 24th day of February, 1948, complainant, Prudie Hill, being present in person, and by her solicitor, L.C. Albright, and the respondent and cross-complainant, H.M. Cowart, in his own proper person, and by his solicitors, Messers. Ellis & Fowler, and the respondent and cross-complainant, O.J. Pardue, in his own proper person, and by his solicitors, S.A. Lokey and E.E. Stewart, and there came twelve men, tried and true, viz: L.N. Wyatt and eleven others, who were duly empanelled to try said cause and the issues presented by the pleadings and the evidence submitted by each of the parties; and the jury having heard all of the testimony and the evidence so submitted, and having heard the charge of the Court as to said issues and the law governing same, and said cause having been so submitted to said jury, and said jury having thereupon returned its verdict in words and figures as follows:

"We, the jury, find the issues in this cause in favor of O.J. Pardue, respondent and cross-complainant, against both complainant Prudie Hill, and respondent and cross-complainant, H.M. Cowart

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS the order, judgment and decree of this Court that the respondent and cross-complainant, O.J. Pardue, is entitled to the relief prayed for in his answer and cross-bill, and the verdict of said jury in this cause is, in all things, and every respect, ratified and confirmed.

It is the further order judgment and decree of this Court that neither the complainant Prudie Hill, nor the respondent and cross-complainant, H.M. Cowart, have any right, title, or interest in or to the lands described in the bill of complaint, or any part thereof, and the title of the said O.J. Pardue is forever quietted against the said Prudie Hill and said H.M. Cowart.

It is the further order, judgment and decree of this Court that a copy of this decree be filed by the Register, in the office of the Probate Judge of Shelby County, Alabama, for recording, and that the recording fee for same be taxed as a part of the costs herein.

It is the further order, judgment and decree of this Court that the costs incurred in this cause be, and the same is hereby taxed and pro-rated, equally, among the said parties, Prudie Hill, H.M. Cowart, and O.J. Pardue, for which let execution issue.
