LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF FRANCIS OLIVER SAMUEL

COUNTY OF DALLAS

I, Francis Oliver Samuel, a resident of Selma, County of Dallas, State of Alabama, and over the age of Twenty-one years, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make and publish this my last will and testament, revoking all former wills which may have been made at any time heretofore by me.

FIRST:

I will that all of my debts and funeral expenses shall be paid by my Executrix as soon after my decease as practical.

SECOND:

I will and bequeath to my beloved wife, Minnie Perry Samuel, all of my Estate, Real, Personal and mixed.

I nominate and appoint my wife, Minnie Perry Samuel, as Executrix of this my last will and testament, and that she shall not be required to give any bond for the performance of her duties arising hereunder, nor shall she be required to make any inventory of the property coming into her hands, as such executrix, nor to make any report to any Court of her proceedings hereunder.
