Personally came and appeared before me, Wales W. Wallace, Jr., a Notary Public in and for said County in said State, Willie S. Lokey, who, after being first by me duly sworn, deposes as follows:

My name is Willie S. Lokey. I am the wife of S.A. Lokey. Before my marriage to Mr. Lokey I was the widow of of Luther L. Saxon. Grantee in that certain foreclosure deed from Paul O. Luck, auctioneer dated April 8, 1922, and recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama, in deed book 74 at page 108 conveying the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter less one acre in the Southwest Quarter of Section 10, Township 22, Range 2 West and other property.

Mr. Saxon sold timber off above described land and paid taxes on it during his life time. After Mr. Saxon's death in 1932, I have assessed and paid taxes on said property each year.

I have never known of anyone disputing or questioning in anyway the title of Luther L. Saxon to above described lands from the year 1922 to the time of his death in 1932 nor have I ever known of anyone questioning or disputing my title since that time. I derive my title to said property from foreclosure deed of Wales W. Wallace, auctioneer to O.H. Sparks dated October 29, 1932 and recorded in the office of Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama, in deed book 95 at page 258 and deed from O.H. Sparks, a unmarried man to Willie L. Saxon dated November 21, 1932 and recorded in deed book 95 at page 321, I have never known of G.T. Butler claiming any title to above described land since 1922. I have never known of Fred Smith claiming any title to said land since 1922. I have never known of John W, Hardy claiming any title to said land since 1922.

While said land has not been in cultivation nor under fence, it has been used for the only purpose for which it is suited, viz., the growing of timber since the year 1922.

The constructive possession and such actual possession as has been exercised since 1922 was exercised by my husband L.L. Saxon from 1922 until 1932 by O.H. Sparks for a short time in 1932 and since by me and has been continuous, exclusive, peaceful, quiet, open, hostile, notorious, adverse and under color of title and claimer of ownership and with the assessment and payment of taxes and no other person has paid taxes on said land or in any way exercised any possession or claimer of ownership that has come to affiant's knowledge.
