My name is Mrs. W.D. Collum. I am 53 years of age and have lived in the vicinity of Calera, Alabama, for the past 53 years. I am the wife of W.D. Collum, who purchased 11 4/5 acres of land from Southern Lime Corporation on April 17, 1943, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 117, page 91 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. The land being covered in said deed being described as follows:

11 4/5 acres lying east of Tract 323 Loyds
Townsite addition to Calera, being in Section
22, Township 22, Range 2 West, Shelby County
Alabama.

I am also familiar with the following described land now owned and occupied by Lucile Hosey:

A part of the NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 22 Township 22
Range 2 West described as beginning at a point
100 feet west of the southeast corner of said
forty acres and run west along the south line of
said forty acres to the east right of way line
of the Calera-Columbiana Highway; thence in a
northeasterly direction along the south east
line of said right of way to a point 100 feet
west of the east line of said forty acres
(measured at right angles thereto); thence south
to the point of beginning.

I know of my own knowledge that said deed from Southern Lime Corporation to my husband, W.D. Collum, was not intended to cover the land owned and occupied by Lucile Hosey as described above. I further know that my husband, W.D. Collum claims no interest in said land belonging to Lucile Hosey.
