My dear Mr. Luck:

In response to your letter of February 5, 1948, enclosing \$1.68, I enclose certified photostat copies of our official records of 3 patents covering the land described in subparagraphs 2, 3 and 4. The fee for these copies is \$1.20.

Our records show that the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 7, T. 22 S. R. 1 E., Huntsville meridian, Alabama, was selected by the State under the grant made by the act of August 11, 1848 (9 Stat., 281), for internal improvements, approved September 25, 1850, Tuscaloosa List No. 3. No patent was issued, but the approval is the equivalent thereof. In this connection see 115 U.S., 102-51 L.D., 566. For information concerning the disposals made of the land by the State, kindly communicate with the Secretary of State, Montgomery.

If desired, we will furnish you with a certified extract copy of as much of the approved list as relates to the land described for 70 cents, necessitating an additional remittance of 22 cents.

The balance of your remittance, 48 cents, will be retained pending word from you. If we do not hear from you within a reasonable period of time, it will be refunded by the Treasury Department.
