To All To Whom These Presents Shall Come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, John Lowry of Shelby County has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa in Alabama whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said John Lowry according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the East half of the South West quarter of Section Seven, in Township twenty two of range one East, in the District of Tuscaloosa and State of Alabama, containing Seventy nine Acres and ninety seven hundredths of an Acre according to the official plat of the survey of said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said John Lowry

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICAN, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said John Lowry and his heirs the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said John Lowry and to his heirs and assigns forever.
