RIGHT OF WAY DEED FOR PUBLIC ROAD

(Oak Mountain State Park)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Department of Conservation of the State of Alabama, acting by and through its Director, in and for the consideration of one dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid by Shelby County, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and for the further consideration of the benefit accruing to us and to the public from the construction or improvement of a public road through out lands, in Shelby County, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Shelby County, its successors or assigns, a Right-of-way hereinafter described, over and across our said lands in Shelby County, Alabama, for a public road; said right-of-way herein conveyed being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at Station 295/10 of SACP 434, the West property line; thence northeasterly along a curve to the right (concave southeasterly) having a radius of 955.37 feet, adistance of 106.5 feet; thence N 72 29E a distance of 38.7 feet; thence northeasterly along a curve to the left (concave northwesterly) having a radius of 637.27 feet, a distance of 561.1 feet; thence N 21 59 E a distance of 70.4 feet; thence northerly along a curve to the left (concave northwesterly) having a radius of 410.28 feet, a distance of 189.5 feet; thence N 4 33 W a distance of 282.9 feet; thence northeasterly along a curve to the right (concave southeasterly) having a radius of 573.69 feet a distance of 443.5 feet to a point of equation; thence N 39 48 E a distance of 854.5 feet to the point of ending at station 318/70, the north property line.

Said strip of land being 40 feet wide on the southeast (right) side of the centerline of said project, except a parcel from Station 307/00 to Station 311/00, which shall be 60 feet wide, and lying in the NWL of the NWL, Section 24, in the SWE of SWE, Section 13, and in the SEE of SWE, Section 13, Township 19 S, Rn. 2 W, and containing 2 2.2 acres more or less, including that part occupied by the present road.

To Have and To Hold by Shelby County, or its Assigns, and for and in consideration of the benefit to our property by reason of the construction or improvement of said road, we hereby release the County aforesaid, and all of its employees and officers, and the State of Alabama and all of its employees and officers from all consequential damages, present or prospective, to our property, arisign out of the construction, improvement, maintenance or repair of said road, and that said road is a benefit to our property is hereby admitted and acknowledged. All agreements covering the moving, relocating and/or changing of the building and/or structures located wholly or partially on the above described right-of-way shall be in writing and approved by the State Highway Department before the same shall be valid and binding on the said State Highway Department. The grantor hereby grants permission with right of ingress and egress to gra tor's adjoining property at any time during construction period of project for purpose of moving grantorad buildings and/or structures from the above described right-of-way.
