P. Lacey:

Beginning at an iron stob near the old spring on the Elyton and Montevallo Road, run South along said Road two (2) chains and twenty (20) links, including the cedar lane on both sides, thence East three (3) chains and thirty (30) links to Beaver Dam Creek, thence North along said Beaver Dam Creek two (2) chains and 92 links, thence West three (3) chains and 42 links to point of beginning, containing two (2) acres, more or less.

The above described land lying and being in the NE+ of the SE_2 of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW+ of Section 9, Township 21 South, Range 3 West, situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

At the time the aforesaid deed was executed, my sister Cora Harris was a widow and has never remarried. Furthermore, the aforesaid Deed was signed by my sister Kate Lacey as "Kate Lacy", and by my sister Emma Lacey as "Emma Lacy". Kate Lacey and "Kate Lacy" were one and the same person, and Emma Lacey and "Emma Lacy" were also one and the same person. Furthermore, my name is shown as "D. B. Lacy" as one of the grantors in the aforesaid deed which was merely a m stake in the spelling of my last name, for the correct way of spelling my last name is Lacey as shown by my signature to the aforesaid deed.
