## FINAL DECREE

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the prayer of said petition be and is hereby granted that it will be to the best interest of said minor, Joe Alex Tucker, to be unconditionally relieved from the disabilities of non-age unconditionally and without restriction; and that he, the said Joe Alex Tucker, a minor, be and hereby is relieved from the disabilities of non-age unconditionally and without restriction and that he be and hereby is invested with the right to sue and be sued, contract, buy sell and convey real estate and genrally to do and perform all acts which he could lawfully do if twenty one (21) years of age; that a duly certified copy of this decree be filed of record in the office of the Probate Judge of Shelby County, Alabama; and that the Petitioner pay the costs in this cause incurred.
