SEFFERS ON COUNTY

I, Amy Reece, a resident of the City of Fairfield, County of Jefferson and State of Alabama, over the age of 21 years and of sound mind and disposing memory do hereby make, published and declare this my last will and testament, in manner and form as follows:

First. It is my will that all of myjust debts and furneral expenses be paid as soon after my death as can conveniently be done.

Second. I will, devise and bequeath unto my beloved husband hos. J. Reece, all property, real, personal and mixed, of which I die seized and possessed and to which I have any right, title, claim, interest or equity, to be his absolutely to do with and dispose of as he may see fit and proper.

Third. I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my husband Thos. J. Reece, as sole executor of my will and it is my will that he be not required to give bond for the faithful performance of his duties as such, nor shall my said executor be required to file any inventory or reports in any Court.

Fourth. I hereby give and grant unto my said Executor full and complete power and authority, First; to sell such portionor all of my property as he may see fit and proper, to such persons, for such consideration, and on such terms as he may deem proper for the purpose of paying my joint debts and funeral expenses, or any other purpose; Second, to extend, renew or refinance any indebtedness owing by me at the time of my death and to secure the same by mortgage, deed of trust or other form of lien or incumbrance or any part or all of my property as she may see proper and; Third, it is my will that my said Executor may, if she sees fit and proper, borrow money from time to time, from such persons as she may see fit and in such sum or sums as she may determine, and to secure the same by moregage, deed of trust or other written instrument on such portion or all of my property as she may think proper. That in the exercise of the powers and authority herein granted to my said Executor he shall not be required to make any application to or receive any orderfrom any court, it being my expressed intention that my said Executor shall have as full and complete power and authority in the premises as I could exercise if living, and unto such end my said (humband) Executor is authorized and empowered to make, execut and deliver any and all deeds, mortgages, deeds of trusts or other instruments as in his judgment is necessary and proper to carry out the said power and authority granted unto hims.

Fifth: I hereby revoke any and all other walls or testamentry dispositions at any time heretofore made by me.
