KNOW YE, Mathithe United States of America, in consideration of the promises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Joseph McReynolds and to his heirs the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, theredo, be longing, unto the said Joseph McReynolds and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, I John I Adams President of the United State of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the general Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
