Now, therefore, in cosmideration of the Presmises and the further consideration of \$1,000.00 in hand paid by the Turstees of the Helena-Pelham Charge of the Methodist Church, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I, Frank Head, as Commissioner by appointment of the Circuit Court, Sitting in Equity, do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the Trustees of the Helena-Pelham Charge of the Methodist Church,

their successors and assigns in trust, for the use and benefit of the harge and of the Methodist Church, an undivided one-half interest in the following described real estate to-wit:

Lots 5,6,7, and part of lots 4 and 8 in Block 9 according to Joseph Squires map of the town of Helena, the whole being described as follows: Beginning at a point on the west side of Branch Alley 173 feet north of the north line of Third Avenue and run south 83 degrees west 236 feet to the east line of Third Street thence north along the east line of Third Street to a point 175 feet south of south line of Second Avenue thence east and parallel with Second Street 268 feet to the west line of Branch Alley, thence south along the west line of Branch Alley to the point of beginning.

Also, the south half of lot 2 and all of lots 3,4,5, and all of lot 6 in Block 10 of the said survey, except that part described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the west line of Third Street with the north line of Third Avenue, thence west along said avenue 98 feet to the east line of Fourth Street, thence northwest along the east line of Fourth Street 80 feet, thence east and parallel with the north line of Third Avenue 150 feet to the west line of Third Street, thence south along said Third Street 75 feet to the point of beginning.
