Witnesseth: That for and in consideration of the mutual benefit of the parties the said Edward Preisler hereby lends to the said Freeman Cox one McCulloch Power Chain Saw, Model 1225-A 20", Serial No. 55025, for the hereinafter specified purpose and upon the following condition.

That the said Freeman Cox is to have possession of and use the said saw for the sole purpose of cutting timber to be used to make charcoal for the said Edward Preisler only, and is not to lend same to any other or to move it from one location to another without the full knowledge and expressed consent of the said Edward Preisler, to subject same to no abuse, but maintaining it in good repair and return same on said Edward Preisler's demand at any time in as good as at present condition, natural wear and tear excepted.
