KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of the sum of one dollars to Odis D. Blankenship and wife, Gladys Blankenship in hand paid by Sam Stoudenmire and Vernice Stoudenmire the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged we do remise, release, quit claim and convey to the said Sam Stoudenmire and Vernice Stoudenmire, all our right, title, interest and claim in or to the following described real estate, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the center of the railway tract at the east of a culvert, being the first culvert east of the Wilsonville Depot on the Southern Railway, and run easterly along the center of the Southern Railway tract, a distance of 30 feet; run thence in a northerly line of the Southern Railway 50 feet to an iron stob; run thence in an easterly direction and perpendicular to the center/direction and parallel with and 50 feet from the center line of the Southern Railway 275 feet for a point of beginning of the land herein described; run thence in a northerly direction and parallel with the east line of a lot formerly known as the Grist Mill lot, which is also the east line of the lot described in that certain deed from W.T. Taylor, Jr., and wife, Gertrude Taylor, to R.C. Foster and Roxie M. Foster dated on October 21, 1938, and recorded in the office of Judge of Probate for Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 105 page 315, 272 feet to the north line of said Grist Mill lot; run thence in an easterly direction along the north line of said Grist Mill lot 80 feet; run thence in a southern direction and parallel with the west line of the lot being herein conveyed 272 feet to the north boundary line of the Southern Railway right of way; run thence in a westerly direction along the northern boundary line of said railway right of way 80 feet to point of beginning; being situated in the Town of Wilsonville, Alabama, and in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, Township 21, Range 2 East, Shelby County, Alabama.

This deed is executed for the purpose of correcting that certain deed from the grantors herein to the grantees herein dated May 21, 1948, and recorded in Deed Book 133 page 403 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD to the said Sam Stoudenmire and Vernice Stoudenmire, their heirs and assigns forever.

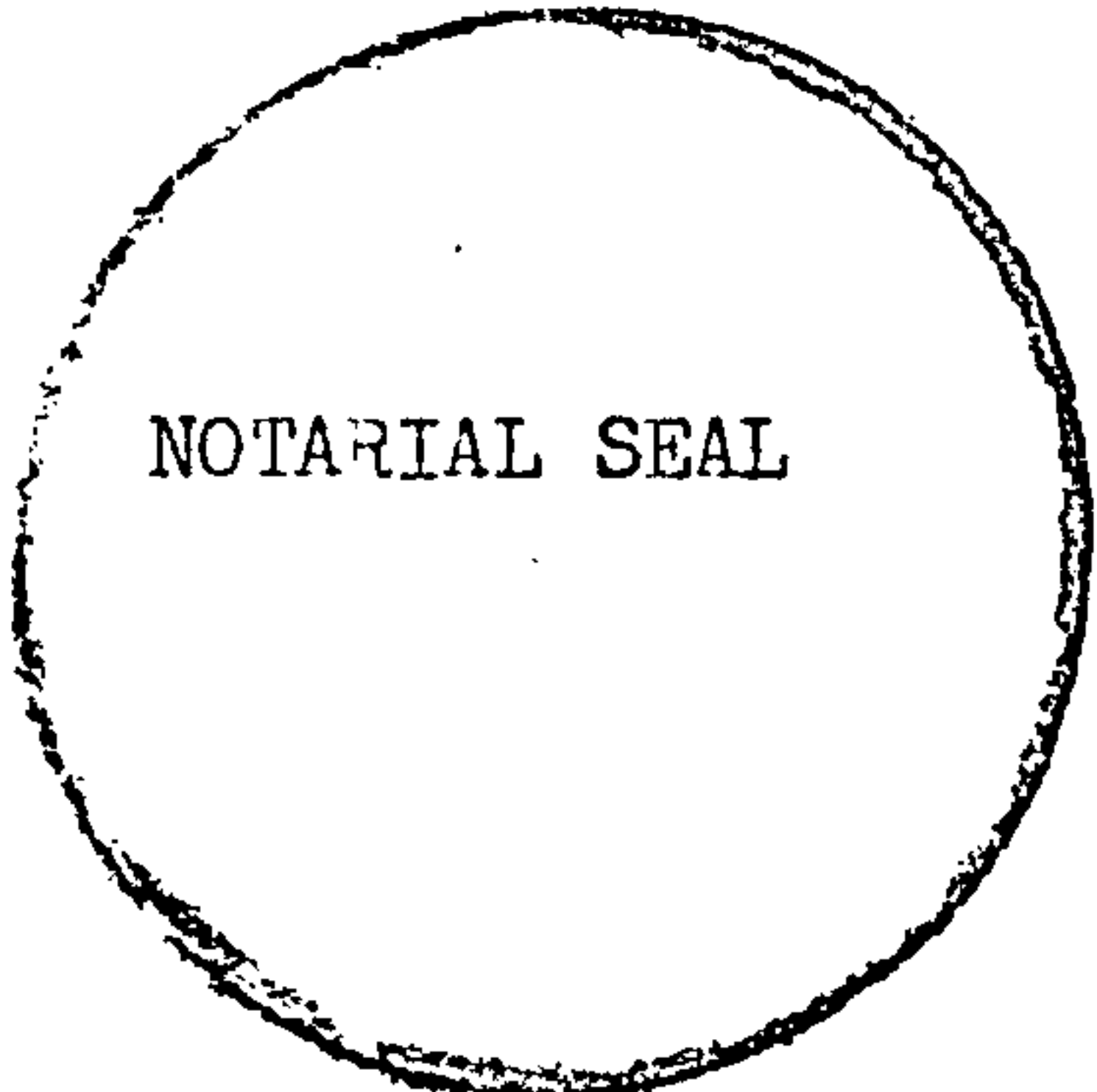

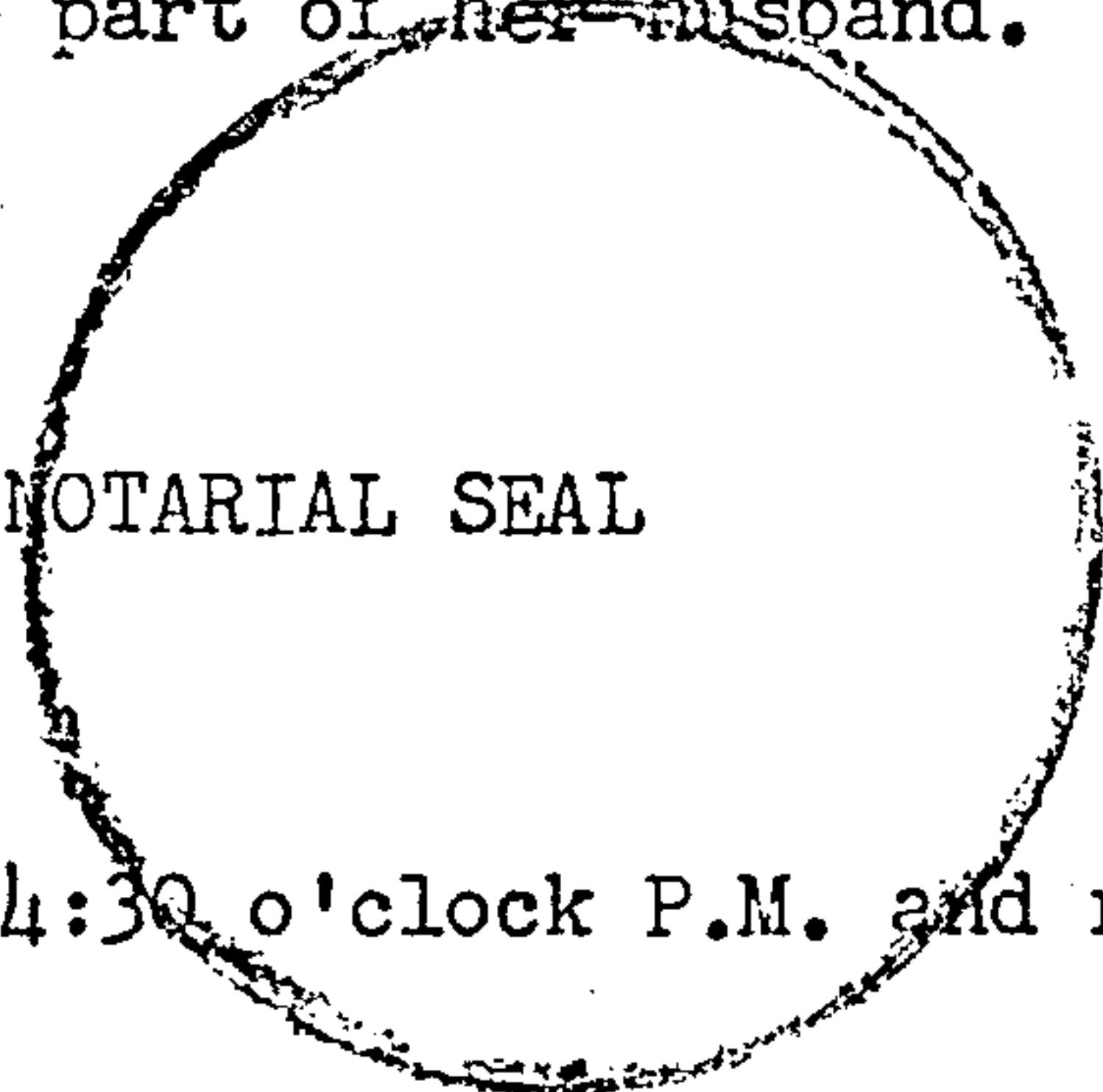
