Anderson and wife, Annis E. Anderson as joint tenants, with right of survivors hip, the following described real estate and personal property, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

Commence at the SE corner of the  $NV_4$  of the  $NE_4$  of Section 18, Township 21, Range 2 West, and run along the south line of said forty acres 341.2 feet to its intersection with the west rightof-way line of the Birmingham-Montgomery Highway for a point of beginning of the tract hereby conveyed; from said point of beginning run south 89 degrees and 40 minutes west 373 feet, more or less, to a pipe on the eastern boundary or margin of the right of way of the Louisville & Nashville Railroad; thence along the eastern margin of the right of way of said railroad north 43 degrees and 55 minutes west 384 feet; thence north 89 degrees and 40 minutes east 415 feet to the western line of the right of way of said Montgomery-Birmingham Highway; thence along the margin of said highway south 39 degrees and 10 minutes east 356 feet to the point of beginning and containing 3.35 acres, more or less. Subject to easement and right-of-way granted to Alabama Power Company, recorded in Volume 99, on page 399 in the office of the Probate Judge of Shelby County, Alabama; including the following personal property now in and on the above premises: 2 floor counters, 1 vegtable counter, 1 computing scale, 1 drink box, 1 heater, 1 Butane gas system including 1 three hundred gallon capacity Butane gas tank, all gas pipe valves etc., 2 gas hea ters, l large wood kitchen cabinet, 3 linoleum rugs, l steel playground swing stand, approximately \$1,000.00 stock of merchandise, all flowers, shrubbry, fruit trees, timber, buildings and fences. Grantees assume a first mortgage against the above real estate to Central State Bank, recorded in Mortgage Book 200, page 13 in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama; said mortgage and accrued interest to date warranteed to be \$2318.69 as of the date of this deed.

Grantees assume and agree to pay the taxes for the current 1948 tax year ending September 30, 1948.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD Unto the said Roy F. Anderson and wife, Annis E. Anderson as joint tenants with right of survivorship, their heirs and assigns forever; it being the intention of the parties to this conveyance, that (unless the joint tenancy hereby created is servered or terminated during the joint lives of the grantees herein), in the event one grantee herein survives the other, the entire interest in fee simple shall pass to the surviving grantee, and if one grantee does not survive the other, then the heirs and assigns of the grantees herein shall take as tenants in common.

And we do, for ourselves and for our heirs, executors and administrators, covenant with the said grantees, their heirs and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from all encumbrances. Except as specifically set out herein; that we have a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; that we will, and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said grantees, their heirs, and assigns forever against the lawful claims of all persons.
