Turner and wife Eunice Turner for and in consideration of the sum of one and no/loo collars (1.0)) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation, the receipt whereof is a cknwoledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliances necessary in connection therewith as located by the final location survey heretofore made by said Company, for the transmission of electric power with the right to string thereon from time to time electric power and telephone wires and the right to permit other corporations, and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon, over and across the following described lands situated in Shelb County Alabama:

Start at NE corner of the South West Quarter of the north East Quarter run west along Quarter Section line 411 ft. to west side of Florida ShoRt Route hwy. for point of beginning thence W along quarter Section line 909 ft. to NW Corner thence South 1320 ft. thence East 70 ft. thence along a made line and top of crest of mountain NEast 1600 ft. to south Boundary of said hwy, thence along SW Boundary of said HWy 600 ft. to point of beginning Section 29, Township 19, South Range 1 West.

In the event it becomes necessary or desirable for Alabama Power Company to move its lines of poles, towers and appliances in connection with the construction or improvement of any public road or highway in proximity

to its said power lines, the said Compay is hereby granted the right to relocate its said lines of poles, towers and appliances on lands of grantors hereinabove described, provided, however, the said Company shall relocate its sial line of poles or towers at a distance not greater than ten feet outside the boundary of the right of way of any such public road or highway as established or re-established from time to time.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full injoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstuctions, that may injure or endanger said lines

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and a ssigns forever.
