Before me the undersigned Notary Public in and for said County and said State personally appeared Mary M. Carroll, known to me, who being by me first duly sworn deposes and says as follows:

Affiant Mary M. Carroll is 77 years of age, having been born in the year 1872. Affiant's father Truman Know died when affiant was about 2 years old and her mother Jennie Know later married T.P. Jones about the year 1876. Affiant is well acquainted with the following described property:

A Part of W_2^1 of SW_4^1 of Sec. 30, Tp. 20, Range 3 West, being the part of said W_2^1 of SW_4^1 of said Section township and Range that lies on the west side of Cahaba River containing 25 acres more or less, also the NW_4^1 of Ne. 31, Tp. 20, R 3 west containing 40 acres, also the NE_4^1 of NE_4^1 of Sec. 36, Tp. 20, R. 4 West containing 39.54 acres, also the SE_4^1 of Sec. 25, Tp. 20, R. 4 West containing 39.83 acres, also the SW_4^1 of the SE_4^1 of Sec. 25, Tp. 20, R. 4 West containing 39.54 acres, all situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

Affiant has known said property and the owners and occupants thereof since her early childhood. When she first knew said property it was owned jointley in equal shares by Michael Stien and affiant's stepfather T.P. Jones. Michael Stein died about the year 1882 and left surviving him his widow Emma Stein and the following childred Christina McCarghy, Fannie E. Kelley, Annie Belle Stith, Hattie Rush, John F. Stein, Charles H. Stein and Emma Screws. The said Michael Stein left no other children of decendants of cheldren surviving him at the time of his death or posthumously since. Affiant's stepfather T.P. Jones died intestate about the year 1885 and left surviving him his widow, affianties mother, Jennie Jones, and the following children as his sole heirs at law: Annie H. Jones now deceased, Tommie Pearl Jones, Arw deceased, Simon G. Jones, now deceased, and Nellie E. Memoli. The said T.P. Jones left no other cheldren or descendants of cheldren surviving him at the time of his death or posthumously since. Affiant's mother, Jennie Jones died in the year 1919. Said Annie H. Jones died on the 4th day of October, 1941, while a resident of Jefferson County, Alabama and left a will naming Tommie Pearl Jones, her sister, as sole beneficiary. The said Tommie Pearl Jones succeeded to the interest of Annie H. Jones in said Property. Simon G. Jones died intestate in the year 1933 and left surviving him his widow, H. Leona Jones, and the following Cheldren: Virginia Jones Moebes, Nellie Blanche Cunningham and Simon G. Jones, Jr., all of whom are over 21 years of age. The said Simon G. Jones left no other cheldren or descendants of cheldren surviving him at the time of his death or posthumously since. Tommie Pearl Jones, half-sister of affiant, (affiant and Tommie Pearl Jones having the same mother but different fathers) died intestate on February 19, 1948 while a resident of Jefferson County, Alabama. Neither Tommie Pearl Jones nor Annie H. Jones were ever married. fommie Pearl Jones left surviving her the following as her six sole and only heirs at law; affiant Mary M. Carroll, sister of the half blood; Nellie E. Memoli, sister, Virginia Jones Moebes, niece, Nellie Blanche Cunningham, niece, and Simon G. Jones, Jr., nephew, all of said heirs of Tommie Pearl Jones being over 21 years of age.

On or about May 18, 1909 by deed recorded in Deed Book 42 Page 516cin the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama and by deed of correction recorded in Deed Book 92, page 137 in said Probate Office the widow and heirs of Michael Stein conveyed their one-half interest in the said property to Tommie Pearl Jones. Affiant states, however, that while title to said one-half interest was taken in the name of Tommie Pearl Jones the entire consideration for said conveyance was furnished by Simon G. Jones, and it was considered and understood by the said Tommie Pearl Jones, Simon G. Jones and the other heirs of T.P. Jones that said one -half interest in the said property so acquired from the widow and heirs of Michael Stein belonged to Simon G. Jones.

Affiant states that the possession of said property by Michael Stein and T.P. Jones from the time affiant first knew said property to the time of their deaths and by their heirs, descendants and assigns aforestated since said time until the present has been continuous, open, notorious peaceable and adverse, that they have farmed part of said lands, cut the timeber from all parts of it over said period of years and have paid the taxes each year on all of said lands, after the death of said Simon G. Jones the said property was and still is assessed in the name of his widow and the taxes have been paid by her. Affiant states that she has never heard of any one disputing or asserting any adverse claim to the title of Michael Stein and T.P. Jones or those claiming under them to said lands.
