Before me the undersigned authority in and for said county in said state personally appeared, Idalèee
Holcombe, who is known to me and who being by me first duly sworn deposes and says that she is a resident of
Shelby County, Alabama and resides on lands adjoining the hereinafter described real estate. That she is the widow
of Arthur Holcombe, deceased. That her said husband, Arthur Holcombe, received a deed to the real estate on which
she now resided and on which the said Arthur Holcombe was living at the time of his death in division of an
estate, on March 12, 1935. That she is familiar with the lands owned and claimed by Edna Earle O'Neal which
adjoin the lands now occupied by affiant and which are described as follows:

94 acres of land or irregular oblong shape lying in the SE corner of Section 2 Township 22 Range 3 West, and being part of a tract of land which was heretofore known as the "Moore Place" and which 94 acres hereby conveyed is described as follows:

Beginning at the SE corner of said section 2 and running West along the south line of said section to the Montevallo and Ashville public road, a distance of 44 chains, thence northerly along the east side of said public road 20.14 chains, thence easterly 44.67 chains to the section line between sections land 2 which is 22.25 chains north of the point of beginning, thence south along said land line to the beginning corner.

Also all of the \mathbb{E}^1_2 of SW^1_4 of Section 2 Township 22 Range 3 West lying south of Moore's Spring Branch and west of the Montevallo and Ashville public road, as the same is now located.

Said tract of land hereby conveyed being more particularly described as follows: beginning on the south line of section 2 which is 300 feet west of the $S^{\underline{B}}$ corner of the $S^{\underline{B}_1}$ of $S^{\underline{M}_1}$ of said section 2, said point being the intersection of the south line of said section with the west line of said Montevallo and Ashville public road, thence west 1020 feet to the $S^{\underline{M}}$ corner of the $S^{\underline{B}_1}$ of $S^{\underline{M}_1}$, thence north to Moore Spring Branch, thence in a NEly direction acong said branch to the west line of said public road, thence southerly along west line of said road with its meanderings to the point of beginning, the same being 30 3/4 acres more or less.

That she has been familiar with said lands for more than twenty years and that during said twenty years all of the within described lands have been in the possession of and occupied by J.C. Rogers and his wife Hazel Marie Rogers, Josie Henderson Cohron and the said Edna Earle O'Neal and that each of the said prties have been owners of said land that during the time of the ownership of each they have had actual, continous, notorious, hostile, peaceable adverse possession of said lands. That no other person, as to the knowledge of affiant, ever claic claimed any right, title or interest in said lands for more than twenty years. That the said Edna Earle O'Neal is at present the owner and in possession thereof, That during the time each of the above parties owned said land they lived on it and cultivated same.
