Smith and his assigns, all and singular the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Eight, in Township 24 North, of Range 12 East of St. Stephens Principal Meridian in the County of Shelby, State of Alabama.

To have and to hold to the said Hampton S. Smith and his heirs and assigns forever.
