I checked the records of the Tax Assessor of Shelby County, Alabama, for the tax year 1928 and found that W. B. Browne Estate assessed, along with other lands, the following land; "NE¹/₄ of NE¹/₄ of Section 18, Township 21, Range 1 ~~West~~^{W¹/₂ of NE¹/₄; NW¹/₄ of SE¹/₄; and SE¹/₄ of NE¹/₄ of Section 18, Township 21, Range 1 East}". I also checked the assessment records of said office for the year 1929 and founddthat said Estate, for the year 1929, assessed, along with other lands, the following described land; "NE¹/₄ of NE¹/₄ of Section 18, Township 21, Range 1 West; W¹/₂ of NE¹/₄; NW¹/₄ of SE¹/₄; and SE¹/₄ of NE¹/₄ of Section 18, Township 21, Range 1 West".
