## AFFIDAVIT

My name is William Joseph Horsley, Jr., I am over the age of twenty-one years and am a son of Mary Ella Horsley, deceased. She died on the 15th day of February, 1949. My mother had never been in business nor had she ever bought and sold on credit in her own name. She was sick for many months before her death and I know that there are no claims against her estate. I also know that at the time of her death, the only property which she owned was her homestead which is described as follows:

Part of Lot 57 according to Horsley's Map of Columbiana, Alabama described as beginning on the south side of East College Street  $158\frac{1}{2}$  feet east of Catherine Street, which point is the northeast corner of the residence lot of Irene Tinney; thence easterly 812 feet along East College Street to northwest corner of Leonard lot; thence in a southeasterly direction along Leonard Lot 206 feet; thence westerly and parallel to East College Street  $81\frac{1}{2}$  feet to the Irene Tinney lot; thence along same in a northerly direction and parallel to Leonard Lot 206 feet to the point of beginning; being situated in the town of Columbiana, Shelby County, Alabama.

Since the date of her death, my brother, Charles Henry Horsley, and I, on the 18th day of February, 1949, conveyed to our sister, Elizabeth Horsley Brock, our interest in said land. The deed is recorded in Deed Book 138 Page 41 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.
