Lots 1 thru 6 Block 197 Lots 1 thru 8 Block 208

Lots 5 thru 8 Block 211 of Dunstan's map of Calera. All of said lots fronting on second street, and power line to be run as per sketch or plat Tast submitted by Representives of Grantee herein.

In the event it becomes necessary or desirable for Alabama Power Company to move its line s of poles, towers and appliances in connection with the construction or improvement of any public read or highway, in proximity to its said power lines, the said Company is hereby gtanted the right to relocate its said lines of poles, towers and appliances on lands of grantors hereinabove described, provided, however, the said Company shall relocate its said line of poles or towers at a distance not greater than ten feet outside the boundary od the right of way of any such public road or highway as established or re-established from time to time.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, inckuding the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns forever.
