The $S^{\frac{1}{14}}$ of the $S^{\frac{1}{14}}$ Sec 12, Township 19 R 2 W. this easement or right of way, shall apply only to proposed live as shown by map on plan of same as exhibited to the undersigned.

Grantors agree that they will not build any structura; within 15 feet of th-e/center line of said right of way.

In the event it becomes necessary or desirable for Alabama Power Company to move its lines of poles, towers and appliances in connection with the construction or improvement of any public road or gighway in proximity to its said power lines, the said Company is hereby granted the right to relocate its said lines of poles, towers and appliances on lands of grantors hereinabove described, provided, however, the said Company shall relocate its said line of poles or towers at a distance not greater than ten feet outside the boundary of the right of way of any such public road or highway as established or re-established from time to time.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees that may injure or endanger said lines within fifteen feet of line.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns forever.
