This mortgage is recorded in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, in Mortgage Book 11,1 at page 31,1 At the time of my husband's death there was Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars balance due on this indebtedness and the mortgage and notes were in the Columbiana Savings Bank for collection. I gave the money to Mr. Garrett's brother, Alfred V. Garrett and he paid the mortgage and notes andbrought them to me, I had them in my possession, but have misplaced, lost ordestroyed them. I do not known what become of them, but do known that I had these papers in my hands and that they were marked, " paid". No one has made any claim under this mortgage since 1930 when it was paid off. I do not know the whereabouts of David H1 Copeland. I have not seen or heard from him since 1930.
