Affiant states that the above described land was conveyed by J. W. Hale and wife, D. A. Hale, to J. L. Hale by warranty deed dated November 2, 1909, which said deed is recorded in Deed Book 43, page 81, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. Affiant further states that J. L. Hale took possession of the above described land upon the execution and delivery of the deed referred to above and held the same openly, adversely, notoriously, exclusively, continuously, claiming the same to be his own from said November 2, 1909 up and until his death on March 26, 1939, escept for a three-day period on March 8, 1937 when he conveyed said described land to Errol Hale by warranty deed recorded in Deed Book 100, page 294, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama; that on March 11, 1937, Errol Hale, a single man, reconveyed to J. L. Hale and his wife, Hattie Hale, said land.

Affiant further states that upon the death of J.L. Hale, his widow, Mrs, Hattie Hale, remained in actual possession of said above described land, and that on January 19, 1940, all of the surviving children of J.L. and Hattie Hale conveyed their interest in and to said land to said Hattie Hale.

Affiant further states that on January 3, 1936, Mrs. Hattie Hale, a widow, conveyed by warranty deed said above described land to Pervie Vanderslice, said warranty deed being recorded in Deed Book 122, page 299, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, Affiant further states that the said Pervie Vanderslice took possession of the above described land upon the execution and delivery of said deed and held the same adversely, claiming the same to be his own until July 29, 1946, when he conveyed the E_2^1 of the above described tract of land to Jessie Driver; that upon the execution of said deed the said Jessie Driver took possession of the E_2^1 of the above described land and occupied the same until October 11, 1947 when he conveyed a part of the E_2^1 of the above described land to L.H. Driver, said land being conveyed by warranty d eed dated October 11, 1947 and recorded in Deed Book 132, page 443, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, and said land being described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the north line of the Columbiana public road where it intersects the east line of the W_2^1 of NW_4^2 of Section 17 Tp 21 Range 2 West and running north along said boundary line 135 feet, thence westerly and parallel with the north line of the Columbiana road 250 feet thence south and parallel with the east boundary of the W_2^1 of NW_4^2 of Sec. 17 Tp 21, R 2 W. to the north line of the Columbiana public road, thence easterly with said road to the point of beginning.

Affiant further states that Pervie Vanderslice, Jessie Driver and L. H. Driver have occupied their respective parts of the above described land openly, adversely, notoriously, exclusively and continuously, claiming the same to be their own from the time of the execution of their respective deeds up to and including the date of the making of this affidavit, and that their predecessors in title have occupied STATE OF ALABAMA the land in the same manner as aforesaid for more than forty years.
