The lands described in that certain right of way grant heretofore executed by the grantors herein to Southern Natural Gas Corporation dated September 17th, 1929, and which is recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, in Volume 90 at page 439.

Together with all other rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use of the rights herein granted, including, but without limiting the same to, the free right of ingress and egress, over and a cross said lands for the purposes aforesaid; together with the right, from time to time, to cut and keep clear all trees, undergrowth, and other obstructions that may injure or endanger any of said lines.
