KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of the sum of One and no/100 Dollars to J. Burrell Williams, an unmarried man in hand paid by Nathan L. Mooney, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged I do remise, release, quit claim and convey to the said Nathan L. Mooney, all my right, title, interest and claim in or to the following described real estate, to-wit:

Begin at the intersection of the Southern boundary of West College Street, in the Town of Columbiana, Alabama, and the eastern boundary of that certain alley which intersects said West College Street at a point opposite the lot formerly known as the Methodist Parsonage lot and run in a southerly direction toward the L & N Depot, and run in easterly direction, along the said southern boundary of said West College Street, a distance of 69 feet, more or less to the Northwest corner of J.R. Meigs, lot; thence in a southerly direction along the line of Meigs lot, 63 feet; thence in an easterly direction 2 feet and 6 inches; thence in a southerly direction along said Meigs line 72 feet, more or less, to the Northeast corner of Simon Davis lot; thence in a westerly direction along the Simon Davis line, 67 feet, more or less to the eastern boundary of the above named alley; thence in a northerly direction along said eastern boundary of said alley 135 feet, to point of beginning.

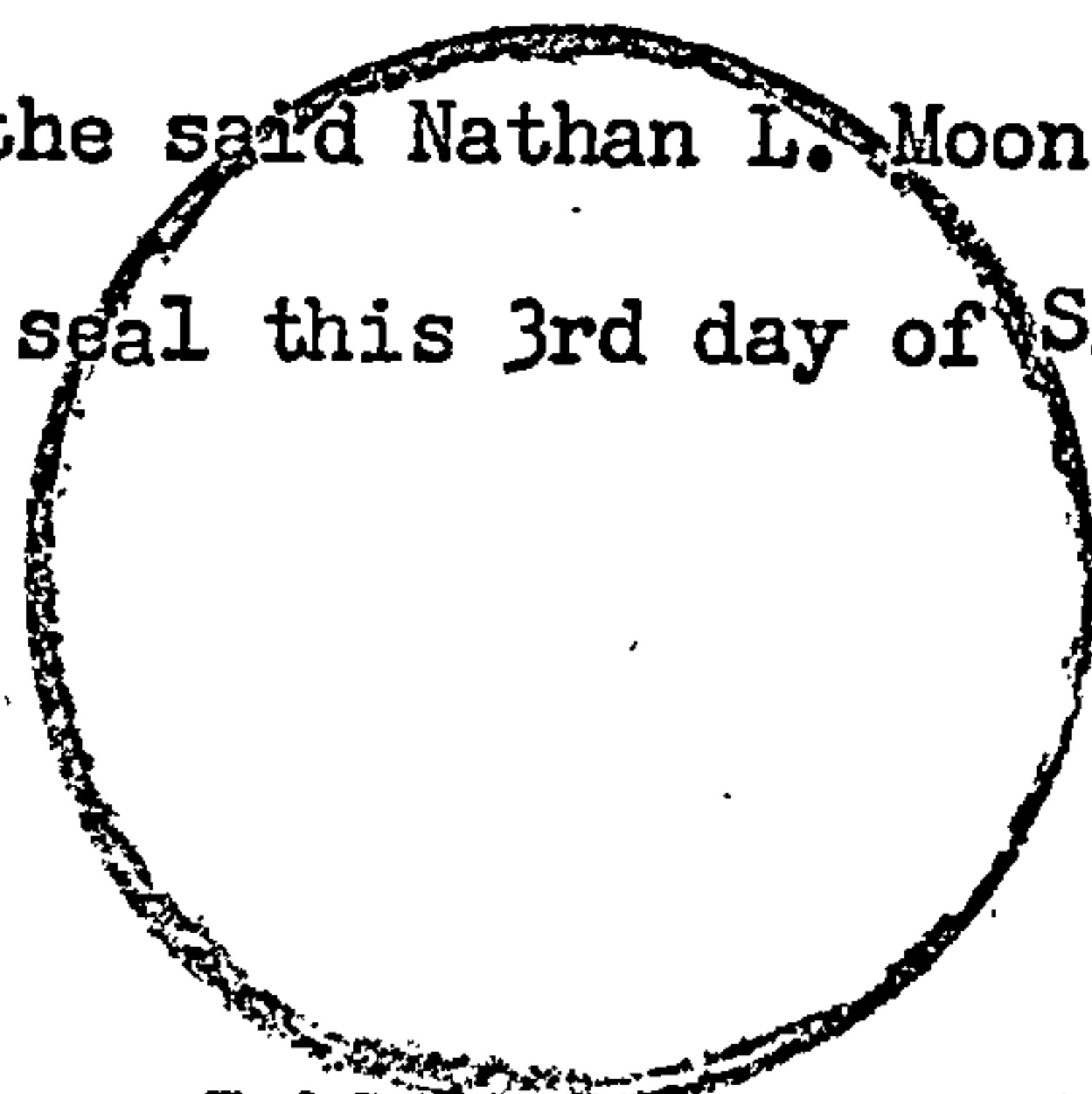
