Personally came and appeared before me, W.K. Slack, a Notary Public in and for said County in said State, Mr. H.D. Austin, who after being first by me duly sworn, according to law to speak the truth deposes and says that on March 20, 1919, he conveyed to W.S. Murphy, the north half of the southwest quarter of Section 8, Township 22, Range 2 West, that several months thereafter the said W.S. Murphy reconveyed said property to affiant and that later affiant sold and conveyed said property by deed of January 11, 1921, to E.T. Pitts, who on October 16, 1922, conveyed said property to Eli Bynum, Jr.

Said W.S. Murphy and his wife are now both dead; that they have one daughter who is married and lives in California, I know of my own personal knowledge that neither W.S. Murphy, his widow, their daughter nor any one has at any time since 1922 been in possession of any part of above described land nor made any claim thereto, adverse to said Eli Bynum, Jr. or his successors in title.

Affiant was well acquainted with the above named Eli Bynum, Jr., and know of his own personal knowledge that he is now dead and his widow married C.L. Jones, that the said Eli Bynum, Jr. left surviving him, his widow and two children, James E. Bynum, a son who is unmarried and Dorothy Bynum, who married Winston H. Garrett and no other heirs.
