I have been shown the deed of C.R. Allen and wife, Lola Allen and Julia Allen to R.P. Waddell and wife, Eva A. Waddell which is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 130 at page 267, but in that deed the original of which is before me, the land is described as being in Range 1 West whereas it should be Range 1 East. This land lies East of land which I own and I have known it for thirty years or more. Evidently the draftsman placed the land in Range 1 West when it should have been Range 1 East.

The Allens lived upon this land for a couple of years before they sold it to Mr. and Mrs. Waddell. The Allens owned no land in Range 1 West at the time this deed was made.

The Waddells went into possession of the land when they bought it from the Allens and are still in possession of it through tenants.
