

AFFIDAVIT

Before me, Julius S. Pilgreen, Jr., the undersigned authority in and for said county, in said State, personally appeared Mrs. S.M. Tomlin, who, after being by me first duly sworn to speak the truth, deposes and says:

My name is Mrs. S.M. Tomlin. I have lived in Calera, Alabama, for the past twenty-eight years and have all along been well acquainted with the following described lots and the persons in possession of them. Said lots being described as follows:

Lots 17, 18 and 19 in Block 4 according to map of Storrs and Fletchers Survey of E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Township 24, Range 13 East, in the Town of Calera, Alabama, said map being recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Ala. M

My husband, S.M. Tomlin, purchased said lots in November, 1923, and went into immediate possession of them and used them as a garden plot each and every year until he sold them to J.P. Warren in the year 1943. J.P. Warren went into immediate possession of said lots and used them for a garden plot or a chicken yard each and every year until this very day and said lots have been under fence continuously from the time my husband purchased said lots until this very day. I have never known of anyone disputing the title or contesting the possession of either S.M. Tomlin or J.P. Warren to said lots.
