In the event it becomes necessary or desirable for Alabama Power Compay to move its lines of poles, towers, and appliances in connection with the c nstruction or improvement of any public road or highway in proximity to its said power lines, the said Company is hereby granted the right to relocate its said lines of poles, towers and appliances on lands of grantors hereinabove described, provided, however, the said Company shall relocate its said line of poles or towers at a distance not greater than ten feet outside the boundary of the right of way of any such public road or highway as established or re-established from time to time.
